





FOPAWS NEEDS A SHORT COMMITMENT FROM YOU TO PROVIDE A NEW LIFE FOR THEM

FOPAWS, Friends of Pets and Wandering Strays — the non-profit, all-volunteer rescue group for Fall Creek — has experienced a recent increase in abandoned and lost pets in our community.

Because we are neither a shelter nor a substitute for Harris County Animal Control, we must rely on our neighbors and friends to step forward and provide temporary shelter for these displaced and frightened pets. When a lost or stray dog or cat has been found in Fall Creek and is safely contained (please be very cautious when approaching an unfamiliar animal), FOPAWS can step in to help. We will quickly scan the pet for a microchip, check for matches in various lost and found databases/social media, nextdoor and post pictures on our Facebook page (Fopaws-of-Fall-Creek) and community website (Fall Creek Community) in an attempt to locate an owner. Once in foster care we will also provide food, supplies and medical treatment.

But we are critically short of volunteer fosters. Without this important support, there is no way for FOPAWS to help. Understanding that our county's facilities and shelters (SPCA, Houston Animal Control or BARC) do the very best they can, these places are neither nurturing nor welcoming environments. Despite their best efforts, in many cases the animals are ultimately euthanized.

To help save these pets, we need your commitment of time and love.

We are working to compile a list of foster homes and would love to add your family's name! Our goal is to add enough families to enable 2-to 4-week rotations while we work to find new, forever homes. All vetting and supplies needed for the pet while in your care are paid for by FOPAWS. A foster would be responsible for providing a loving, safe environment for the dog/cat and helping to rehome the animal by transporting them to and from vet appointments and meet and greets.

Fostering can be very rewarding and will change the animal's life! Will you help by allowing us to add your name to the Fall Creek FOPAWS Foster List? Please send your information and/or questions on fostering to us at FallCreekFOPAWS@gmail.com.




DID YOU KNOW???

Fall Creek is on the former site of the El Dorado Country Club

Humble became a boomtown in 1904, when oil was discovered nearby and the townsite was laid out. By the time the Lone Star Hotel was built and thirty wells were completed several months later, 10,000 people lived in the area, and by 1905 the Humble oilfield was the largest producing field in Texas. Numerous businesses were established over the next five years, including a bank, a theater, a dry-goods store, hotels, and in 1909 the Oil City News, which became the Harris County Sun in 1935. By 1906, however, production declined, the population fell to 7,500, and the community lost its original town government. Ross S. Sterling operated a feed store at Humble before he entered the oil business and founded Humble Oil and Refining Company (now Exxon Company, U.S.A.) in 1911, but moved his headquarters to Houston in 1912.
