ATTENTION FALL CREEK RESIDENTS!

The Architectural Review Committee (ARC) has adopted new guidelines pertaining to exterior home improvements & modifications. The new guidelines were put into effect in October 2023 with the purpose of providing clarification as well as to expand the guidelines to better align with the needs of the community. The revised guidelines can be found on the Fall Creek website within the Document Library.

As a reminder...

All exterior improvements and modifications must receive approval from the ARC prior to beginning any work, however, a documented approval will still be required even if the work has already been completed. This includes, but is not limited to, fence replacements or relocations, landscaping (removal, replacement, or modification), repainting of the home, and installation of lawn decorations and playscapes. Waiting until your project is complete before requesting approval invites the risk of being denied and you may be required to alter or completely reverse any changes made to your lot. Obtaining ARC approval is a necessary step in ensuring that the improvements made to the home are appropriate for Fall Creek and comply with the Community's Design Guidelines and protects

COMMERCIAL VEHICLE SIGNAGE UPDATE

As many of you may know, the Association has been working with residents to collect enough signatures to petition the County to install signs prohibiting overnight parking of commercial vehicles on public streets within the subdivision. We are pleased to announce that the petition was a success, and the new restriction will be enforceable throughout the community.

What does this mean?

Vehicles that meet the Texas Transportation Code's definition of a commercial vehicle will be prohibited from being parked on any public street within the residential subdivision between the hours of 10PM-6AM. Vehicles parked in violation of the statute should be reported by calling the HCSO non-emergency dispatch center at 713-221-6000 (option 1). With signage in place at each entrance to the neighborhood, the deputies will be able to direct the owner to remove the vehicle from the subdivision.

We want to thank all of the Fall Creek residents who made this a possibility, as well as our deputies for their continued support throughout the process.

Simply call the non-emergency number at (713) 221-6000 and let them know when you'll be away. Or fill out the form online by following this link: apps. harriscountyso.org/Programs/programs_VacationWatch.aspx

Be sure to provide them with your Name, address, Date/Time you will be gone, License plate of vehicles that should be on the premises while you are gone and emergency contact information. Also, be sure to select the proper HCSO Contract which will either be MUD 96(Fall Creek)-D2, or MUD49-D2.

Break down and disguise some boxes:

We get it, that new flat screen and hard-to-find game console are awesome! We want you to enjoy them for a long time! One way to make that happen is by not displaying boxes of big-ticket items on trash and recycling day. Break down the boxes and put them in black bags.







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
